Youth rugby is normally safe and injuries are rare. Nevertheless, prevention is better than cure and, for our part, many of our coaches have Rugby Football Union qualifications and have also attended first aid courses. A medical problem or disability does not necessarily preclude a child from playing rugby, but your child's coach should be aware of anything to look out for and, if symptoms become apparent, what to do. Also, in the unlikely event of an injury when you are not present, we should be able to authorise emergency treatment.

**As a precautionary measure, please let us know if your child suffers a serious injury, particularly
concussion or a head injury, at home or at school.**

TETANUS

We strongly recommend that all players are up-to-date with anti-tetanus injections.

**MOUTH-
GUARDS**

It is compulsory for players to wear mouthguards during matches and training sessions from the age of U9, and strongly recommended for all other players. We will arrange for mouthguards to be fitted at the beginning of the season and will advise you of the likely date. Temporary mouthguards are available from most sports shops.

If you have any particular medical or first aid qualifications and would be prepared to help, please advise your child's age group coach.
